

GUIDELINES FOR PRYME PROGRAMME APPLICATION

All applicants must provide the following information to be considered:

- SVG Identification (ID#);
- National Insurance (NIS#);
- Proof of address.

All quotations for the procurement of equipment, supplies and services must be supported by an original, valid and recent Proforma invoice/bill from a local or foreign supplier.

The PRYME Steering Committee or PRYME Implementation Unit may, as it sees fit, attach specific conditions or requirements as a precondition to awarding Grants or additional disbursements.

Applicants are entitled to only one PRYME Grant in a calendar year.

Additional Requirements Based on Grant Amount

For grant requests under \$5,000:

• Attend half-day business training session administered by the Centre for Enterprise Development

For grant requests between \$5,000 and \$15,000:

• Provide a basic business proposal detailing medium-term projections of business income and expenses, target market and sustainability. The Centre for Enterprise Development can assist in the development of the business proposal.

For grants between \$15,000 and \$40,000:

- Provide detailed business plans and proof of legal status of the business.
- Applicants will undergo specific training and supervision by the Centre for Enterprise Development.

By signing this agreement, I certify that:

- The information in this application is true and correct.
- I have read and understand the "Guidelines for PRYME Application," and that I will comply with those Guidelines.
- I agree to give the Ministry of Finance, Economic Planning, Sustainable Development and Information Technology, through the Centre for Enterprise Development, the PRYME Implementation Unit or any of its agencies, the authority to conduct periodic monitoring and evaluation exercises of the business operation to determine whether the expenditure have or is contributing to the success of the business.
